SWIMMING POOL SAFETY TIPS— Please review the following information to keep your pool a safe and fun summer activity for your family.

Supervision

- Never take your eyes off children in the water—not even for a minute! Parents may think they'll hear splashing and screaming when a child is in trouble, but when a child drowns, it usually happens quickly and silently.
- Don't allow a young child in the pool without an adult.
- Knowing how to swim doesn't make a child drown-proof. Never use flotation devices as a substitute for supervision.

If a child is missing, check the pool first. Seconds count in preventing death or disability.

Install Barriers at Home Pools

- A barrier, such as a fence that is at least 4 feet high, must surround the pool or spa. The gate or door must be self-closing and self-latching with the latch out of a child's reach. If the house serves as one side of the barrier, there must be an alarm on doors that have direct access to the pool.
- For above-ground and inflatable pools with ladders, **remove** or secure the **ladder** when the pool is not in use.
- A power safety pool cover or safety cover for spas is another barrier option. The safety cover must meet ASTM standard F1346-91. If the safety cover meets standards, additional barriers, such as fencing, may be optional—check with your local city building department.

Police Chief's Corner:

As we enter the summer season and warm weather, we often leave doors and windows open during the day and evening. If that sounds like you, remember to place something in the window track, so you can have it partially open, but still secure it. The same can be done with sliding glass doors if you have them. When you are not at home or in the evening hours, keep exterior doors to your residence locked. Also, when you are not at home; leave a light, radio or TV on inside the residence. A radio or TV on inside the residence gives the appearance that someone is home. At night, you should leave an outside porch or patio light on. It is recommended that you park your vehicle in a well lit or secure area, and do not leave valuables in the vehicle.
