## Utility Billing Facts—Did you know.....

- If your bill shows a **"PREVIOUS BALANCE"**, that amount is **due immediately**. A \$5.00 late charge has been added to your new balance along with the **current charges** that are **due at the end of the month**.
- The **"PREVIOUS BALANCE"**, if **unpaid** triggers a shut-off notice on the 15th of the month. The **past-due** portion **must be paid to avoid water being shut-off**.
- Making a **utility payment online** through the City website ([www.ci.everson.wa.us](http://www.ci.everson.wa.us)) does not cost additional fees to use. It's quick, easy, and the best part is your account is credited right away. Look for the green **"Pay Your Bills Online"** symbol.
